Since fall 2015 there is a so called "Transitzentrum"in Manching and Ingolstadt. Here, refugees from so called "safe countries of origin" and from countries with a low perspective of stay in Germany are admitted.

How does the asylum process in a transit camp work? What does on have to pay attention for? Which legal possibilies are there for refugees, to undergoe agains a negative decision? What are the rules and regulations for refugees in transitcamps? These and more questions will be answered in this multilingual event** by the asyl rights lawyer Ms. Maria Kalin. After her presentation, there is a possibility to ask indivudual questions and get councelling. Invited are all refugees and their supporters as well as all interested people.

The event is free of charge. Refugees from Manching/Ingolstadt get an INVG single way bus ticket (worth 3 Euro).
